# g3 Identifies Grant Finalists



Girls Giving Grants (g3) met February 9 to narrow the focus for their \$10,300 grant. From 36 applications received in the fall, g3 members selected 8 semi-finalists in January. Deeper review and presentations among the members culminated in a membership vote for two finalists: Friends of the Children Austin; and Mother's Milk Bank in Austin.

Site visits to the finalists will be conducted on April 4, after which Girls Giving Grants will vote for their 2020 grant recipient. Find out all the details on our <u>blog</u>.

# Impact Austin Grant Review Moves to Next Phase

All Grant Review Committees (GRCs) have advanced Impact Austin's grantmaking to a deeper review of select applicants.

From 94 Letters of Inquiry (LOIs), <u>16 nonprofits</u> <u>have been invited</u> to submit full proposals for three Program Grants of \$100,000 each. Applications for the Community Grant, Education Grant, and Health and Well-Being Grant will be due February 21.

Impact Austin received 22 full applications for the \$100,000 Catalyst Grant. <u>Five organizations have been selected for deep-dive review.</u>

Semi-finalists will be identified in late March, with April site visits to follow.
