

The Austin Involved Board Internship Program cultivates the next generation of philanthropists and board members for Central Texas. Our nonprofits need diverse and informed community leaders to steward their missions. This collaborative partnership and multi-session virtual program explains how nonprofit boards work, grows leadership skills, and increases awareness about the diversity, equity, access, and inclusion deficits within the nonprofit sector. Topics covered by experts in the field include: the nonprofit cycle and board responsibilities, how to identify your cause, diversity and inclusion, as well as governance and fiduciary responsibilities.

How to Apply

Applications are due by August 1, 2020. Acceptance emails will be sent by mid-August.

Time Commitment

The program features educational videos (approximately 20 - 30 minutes each) with self-guided activities (10 - 20 minutes). Group and panel discussions, via Zoom, complement the information provided and foster robust conversation about the topics. Videos and activities are provided the Friday before the group discussion/panel to allow participants 4 days to complete them. The success of the program depends on the full commitment of each participant to view the videos, complete the activities, and participate in the panel and group discussions.
